CBAM: Carbon border adjustment mechanism
MSR: Market Stability Reserve
TNAC: Total Number of Allowances in Circulation

- Banking provisions
- Registries
- Rules governing new entrants and closures
- Compliance periods
- Allocation methods
- Relative stringency of targets
- Stringency of enforcement
- Eligibility of offset credits
- Intensity targets
- Cost-containment measures
